A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR...

<u>The Central</u> Significance of Holy <u>Week</u>

Week after week we gather in worship and listen to stories about Jesus.

We hear about Jesus teaching and preaching. We are able to witness his miraculous acts of healing, and other feats that defy explanation.

We examine his stories of his compassionate interactions with some and his confrontation with others. And yet, when we recite both the Apostle's and Nicene Creeds, those stories and acts are not mentioned.

Instead the being of Jesus is discussed with regard to His human parent and divine origin and immediately takes us to His prosecution, death and resurrection. These historic creeds tell us that the very central act of our faith is found in the events we pronounce during what is called the great three days or Triduum, Easter and Jesus' ascension.

These events are the events we attribute to God's redeeming work.

I encourage you to remind yourself of God's Love in these events and to relive them by attending Holy Week worship services.

<u>Maundy Thursday</u> is on <u>Thursday, April 6 at 7:30 pm</u>. On this day, which derives its name from Jesus' mandate to love others as Jesus loves us, we hear God's proclamation of forgiveness as our Lenten fast comes to a conclusion.

We are invited to God's table where Jesus transforms a

Passover meal to a hope and promise. The service concludes with the stripping of the altar and chancel reminding us of how Jesus is stripped of his freedom and justice, and sent to his sentencing.


<u>Good Friday</u> is on <u>Friday</u>, <u>April 7 also at 7:30 pm</u>. This service tells us of Jesus death and being laid in a tomb. Death is often an passive act, but Jesus' death is different, as it is the very active act of God's Love.

While we will not be having an Easter Vigil service, should you attend one, it begins in the dark around a fire, and includes stories from throughout the Bible which tell the history of God's redemption. As the story moves on, it moves into the Sanctuary to Baptize and then proclaim Jesus' resurrection.

We will celebrate <u>Easter</u> on <u>Sunday, April 9th at</u> <u>9:30am</u>. You probably know that we celebrate Jesus resurrection from his death and the grave. But in it we, as a Church, begin to live out a resurrected life.

Easter Sunday begins a season of fifty days to both celebrate Jesus' victory, but equally, the Church as an embodiment of Jesus which lives new life that has overcome the fear and guilt that often motivates us.

ELCA SYNOD ASSEMBLY

The Metropolitan Chicago Synod will be meeting for its Assembly on Saturday, June 3rd. Trinity is allowed two delegates as well as the pastor.

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

On April 2nd, Trinity will meet for a Congregational Meeting. At this meeting we will be voting for a second time regarding two amendments to our constitution.

These amendments will change certain requirements for Congregational meetings. The first proposes that we change the quorem from 25 members to 30% of our voting members.

The second is an additional section which will allow participation in congregational meetings via electronic means such as telephone and zoom calls.

Approval of these amendments will need to be by a two-thirds majority vote. If that happens, then Trinity will send in the transcripts/minutes of the congregational meetings and it will be up to the synod to make final authorization of these amendments.

The second act of business at this congregational meeting will be to elect our council members. Due to Covid we had gotten behind on elections, so we will be voting on the entire slate of council members.

We will be proposing that half of the members are voted in for two years, and the others for one year, so that terms will be staggered. The terms of the officers of the council and congregation will also be staggered.

We will be proposing a new president and vice president as Tina Frankiewiscz is nominated as our president and Dena McIntosh is nominated as vice president.

Congregational meetings are also times to invite congregational questions in inquiries, so please bring them on Sunday.

ELCA TEACHING

The ELCA confesses the Triune God — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. In our preaching and teaching the ELCA trusts the Gospel as the power of God for the salvation of all who believe.

ELCA teaching or theology serves the proclamation and ministry of this faith. It does not have an answer for all questions, not even all religious questions. Teaching or theology prepares members to be witnesses in speech and in action of God's rich mercy in Jesus Christ.

SCRIPTURES, CREEDS AND CONFESSIONS

The ELCA's official Confession of Faith identifies the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments (commonly called the Bible); the Apostles', Nicene and Athanasian Creeds; and the Lutheran confessional writings in the Book of Concord as the basis for our teaching. ELCA congregations make the same affirmation in their governing documents, and ELCA pastors and deacons promise to carry out their ministry in accordance with these teaching sources.

This Confession of Faith is more than just words in an official document. Every Sunday in worship ELCA congregations hear God's word from the Scriptures, pray as Jesus taught and come to the Lord's Table expecting to receive the mercies that the Triune God promises. Throughout the week ELCA members continue to live by faith, serving others freely and generously in all that they do because they trust God's promise in the Gospel. In small groups and at sick beds, in private devotions and in daily work, this faith saturates all of life.

TEACHING FOR A LIFE OF FAITH

This connection to all of life is the clearest demonstration of the authority that the canonical Scriptures, the ecumenical Creeds and the Lutheran Confessions have in the ELCA. The Holy Spirit uses these witnesses to create, strengthen and sustain faith in Jesus Christ and the life we have in him. That life-giving work continues every day, as Martin Luther explained in the Small Catechism: the Holy Spirit "calls, gathers, enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth and preserves it in union with Jesus Christ in the one true faith."
